


There are various visual aids

Media design: basic principles



Content	 reduce to the max use meaningful headlines use key words, not sentences
Construction	 clear arrangement rather visuals than text sparing, supportive use of animation
Fonts	 large (>18) sans serif, e.g. Arial (rather than serif fonts) mix capital and small letters max 2 different fonts and <u>highlights</u>
Color	 meaningful variation and accentuation contrast: dark fonts on light background

Some good advice for presenting slides



- 1. Reduce the overall number of slides.
- 2. Take your time while presenting complex slides.
 - → announce show give time to look explain
- 3. Have a short break during slide transitions.
- 4. Integrate "no-show" episodes.
 - ➔ e.g., black/white screen while giving a practical example,
- 5. Vary media.
 - → e.g., chalk board, flip chart, ...
